One of the members namely Prof. Brajesh C. Choudhary, placed before the House a number of documents (some circulars and court judgements) submitted by Dr. Anurag Mishra, Associate Professor in Electronics, to him.

The Governing Body after due deliberations, resolved to refer all cases of LTC recovery as per audit objection of 2011-12 and 2012-13 to the Under Secretary, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, North Block, New Delhi for exemption through the Vice-Chancellor, University of Delhi, Delhi.

11. **Pension of Prof. R.G. Saxena, Ex-Principal**: The letters received from the Deputy Registrar (Finance) and Assistant Registrar (Colleges-T), University of Delhi regarding pension of Prof. R.G. Saxena, Ex-Principal were placed before the House. The Member Secretary explained the whole case in depth. After going into details, the House, felt that payment of full pension as is being advised by University of Delhi will really be a loss to the public exchequer.

The Governing Body after due deliberation resolved to refer the matter again to the University of Delhi seeking clear direction about who will be responsible if the recovery is ordered by the Delhi Govt. Auditors.

12. **Exemption in Service Tax for Educational Institutions**: (Ref. Res. No. 25 dated 21.10.14) Notification No. 06/2014-Service Tax dated 11.7.2014 on the subject - Union Budget 2014-15: Changes in Service Tax from Ministry of Finance (Department of Revenue), Govt. of India making an amendment in the previous notification of the Govt. of India, regarding, exempting the educational institutions from Service Tax for some of the services received by eligible educational institution was placed before the House. It was noted that the exemption in Service Tax is not allowed for any other service except security and sanitation received by us viz. AMC work, Contract, repair etc. The Governing Body after due deliberations resolved to accept the same.

13. **Disciplinary Case**

- 14. **Extraordinary Leave and Pension Contribution of Dr. Himanshu P. Roy**: The request of Dr. Himanshu P. Roy for treatment of his Extraordinary Leave as qualifying service w.e.f 1.1.2013 to 31.12.2014 for Pensionary Benefits on academic grounds was placed before the House. Receipt of Pension contribution of Rs. 2,30,064/- from Nehru Memorial Museum & Library vide Cheque No. 111642 dated 16.2.2015 was also reported. The Governing Body after due deliberations resolved to accede to the request of Dr. Roy on the basis of Pensionary Benefits received from Nehru Memorial Museum & Library subject to approval of University of Delhi.
- 15. **Appointment of Auditor:** The Governing Body resolved to appoint M/s. PVR & Co. (Chartered Accountant) for the third term to audit the college accounts for the year 2014-15 out of the panel approved by the Governing Body vide Res. No. 2(vii) dated 23.3.2013 and University of Delhi vide its letter No. CB-II/263/PoA/DDU(07/2013/261 dated 16.4.2013 for 3 years i.e. 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15.
- 16. **Recommendations of Survey Committee**: The Governing Body considered the recommendation of the Survey Committee (constituted vide Res. No. 37 dated 21.10.2014) meeting held on 4.12.2014 regarding writing off and disposal of unserviceable items. The Governing Body resolved to accept the same and permitted their disposal as per University of Delhi rules.
- 17. **Recommendations of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)**: The following recommendations of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) made in its meeting held on 19.1.2015 were placed before the Governing Body for consideration:

Regarding item at Sr. No. 3, it was resolved that the proforma under reference from the external members be procured and the committee constituted in the recommendations itself to devise a new proforma which should be put up in the next meeting of the Governing Body.

Regarding item at Sr. No. 5, the Governing Body resolved to create a corpus of Rs. 3 crores, out of savings in Students Society Account. It was further resolved that out of the interest of this corpus a Research Endowment Fund be created, which may be utilized to provide seed money of Rs. 1 to 2 lakhs depending upon the discipline to the new faculty.

18. **Rationalisation of Shri Sultan Chand Dropadi Devi Endowment Scholarship**: (Ref. Res. No. 20 dated 1.4.2014) It was reported to the House by Member Secretary that a proposal to the effect that six scholarships at the rate of Rs. 4000/- each to the students securing highest marks in each semester of the three year B.Com (H) will be given out of the interest (Rs. 24,000/- approximately) @ 8% annually, on a total corpus of Rs. 3 lakh was sent to Sultan Chand Dropadi Devi Education Foundation vide letter No. DDUC/2014-15/1312 dated 20.11.2014 for their consent.

Since it was written to them that if the college do not receive any reply regarding confirmation of the proposal, it will be presumed that they do not have any objection in this rationalisation and no reply has been received till date, the Governing Body, therefore, resolved to approve the rationalisation.
