Guidelines for Admission to Undergraduate Courses on the basis of Sports in for the Academic Year 2020-2021.

- This year, University of Delhi conducted a Centralized SPORTS admission process 2020-21 on the basis of evaluation/marking of Merit/Participation SPORTS Certificates only. Due to the unprecedented situation of COVID-19 pandemic and prevailing public health guidelines, Sports Trials (online/offline) were not conducted.
- 2. Admission to UG Courses on the basis of Sports is available only for merit-based UG courses and is not available in courses where admission is based on an entrance test.
- 3. The allotment of College and Courses to eligible applicants on the basis of Sports shall be done in a centralized manner by the University through Centralized Sports Merit List and based on preferences of Colleges and Courses as indicated by the applicant. The allotment of College and Course will be based on the Rank of the applicant in the order of Centralized Sports Merit List and subject to availability of Game/Sport in the College.
- 4. There will be no restriction on the number of Colleges that the applicant may give preference for seeking admission on the basis of Sports. However, allotment of a College and Course to the applicant will be subject to fulfilment of course-specific eligibility criteria and conforming to University regulations.
- 5. The Seat Matrix for Game/Sport available in each College is given in the Seat Matrix Table 1. Applicants are required to use the information given in Seat Matrix Table 1 while registering their preference of College and Course. Applicants should not opt for a College which does not have seats for their respective GAME /SPORT.
 - 6. The applicants are required to refer the UG Bulletin of Information (<u>http://www.du.ac.in/du/uploads/COVID-19/28062020 UG.pdf</u>) for eligibility criteria. They must refer to guidelines for Admissions on the basis of Sports and Course-Specific eligibility criteria given in Sections 2 & 6 of the Bulletin of Information for admission to Undergraduate Courses 2020-21.
- 7. All the declared eligible applicants for admission on the basis of the Sports are required to give their preference for all Colleges and all relevant Courses on their Dashboard at DU UG Admission Portal based on guidelines outlined in Points #3 to #6 above. There is no limit on registering their preferences of Colleges and Courses depending on availability of

respective GAME /SPORT in the Colleges. All eligible applicants desirous of admission as per the Centralized Sports Merit list will be given **only one chance** to register their preferences for Colleges and relevant Courses at DU UG Admission Portal.

- 8. The Dashboard of eligible applicants as per Centralized Sports Merit List on the DU UG Admission Portal will be open for registering their preferences for the allotment of Course and College from Saturday, 12th December 2020 to Tuesday, 15th December 2020. All eligible applicants are informed that no further chance for registering their preferences for allotment of College and Course will be given after Tuesday, 15th December 2020.
- 9. The Centralized Sports Merit List of successful applicants along with the allotment of College and Course will be displayed on DU UG Admission Portal on Saturday, 19th December 2020. The applicants are required to complete the admission formalities in their respective allotted College and Course on DU UG Admission Portal by Wednesday, 23rd December 2020 (Midnight). No further extra time will be given for completing the admission formalities including submission of the College admission fee.
- If Seats under Sports Category remain vacant after the First Sports Admission List of Colleges and Courses, a Second Sports Admission allotment List will be published after Thursday, 24th December 2020.
- 11. An applicant's name appearing in the Centralized Sports Merit List does not guarantee admission in any College and any Course. The admission of the applicant is subject to the fulfilment of course-specific eligibility criteria and the availability of Seats in a GAME /SPORT in the College and Rank in the order of Centralized Sports Merit List.
- 12. Although the applicants have the option to choose as many college–course combinations as they wish, based on their Rank in the Centralized Sports Merit List, they are required to select only those Courses where they meet the specific eligibility criteria and they are required to select only those Colleges which offer seats under their specific GAME /SPORTS category.
- 13. All admissions on the basis of Sports are provisional and subject to forensic examination/verification of the originals of uploaded Merit/Participation Sports Certificate/s of the applicant. An applicant submitting false/fake Merit/Participation Sports Certificates for seeking admission on the basis of Sports shall be debarred from admission to any College for three years. Such admissions will be cancelled and FIR will be registered.
