NOTIFICATION Admission to Under-Graduate Courses 2021-2022 Under Sports Category

- This year, the University of Delhi conducted a Centralized SPORTS admission process 2021-22on the basis of evaluation/marking of Merit/ParticipationSPORTS Certificates only. Due to the unprecedented situation of the COVID-19 pandemic and prevailing public health guidelines, Sports Trials (online/offline) were not conducted.
- 2. Admission to UG Courses based on Sports is available only for merit-based UG courses and is not available in courses where admission is based on an entrance test.
- 3. The Marks awarded based on evaluation of Merit/ Participation Sports Certificate/s uploaded by the applicants for admission to Under-Graduate Courses for the academic year 2021-22 under Sports Category will be notified on the Dashboard of the applicants on Tuesday, 2nd November 2021. The applicants are advised to check their Dashboard at the DU UG Admission portal.
- 4. A Grievance period of three days from Wednesday, 03rd November 2021 to Friday, 5th November 2021 will be given to the applicants to register their Grievances (if any). The UG Sports Grievance Committee of the University will look into the Grievances of applicants related to the marks awarded on their uploaded Merit/ Participation Sports Certificate/s.

"No Email for grievance related to marks awarded based on evaluation of uploaded Sports certificates will be entertained after **Friday**, **5**th **November 2021**(11:59 PM)."

"Applicants are required not to visit the Delhi University Sports Council (DUSC), University of Delhi (DU) for any grievance related to Sports."

5. The Centralized Sports Merit List for each Sport/ Game along with Ranking of applicants for Sports Quota Admissions to UG Courses 2021 will be displayed on the DU UG Portal after the redressal of the grievances of the applicants."

- 6. The allotment of College and Courses to eligible applicants under Sports Category shall be done in a centralized manner by the University through Centralized Sports Merit List and based on preferences of Colleges and Courses as indicated by the applicants. The allotment of College and Course will be based on the Rank of the applicant in the order of the Centralized Sports Admission Merit List and subject to availability of Game/Sport in the College.
- 7. There will be no restriction on the number of Colleges that the applicant may give preference for seeking admission on the basis of Sports. However, allotment of a College and Course to the applicant will be subject to fulfillment of course-specific eligibility criteria and conforming to University regulations.
- 8. The Seat Matrix for Games/Sports available in each College is given in the Seat Matrix Table. Applicants are required to use the information given in the Seat Matrix Table while registering their preference of College and Course. Applicants should not opt for a College that does not have seats for their respective GAME /SPORT.
- 9. The applicants are required to refer to the UG Bulletin of Information (<u>https://admission.uod.ac.in/userfiles/downloads/15092021_UG-Bulletin_compressed.pdf</u>) for eligibility criteria. They must refer to guidelines for Admissions on the basis of Sports and Course-Specific eligibility criteria given in Sections 2& 6 of the Bulletin of Information for admission to Undergraduate Courses 2021-22.
- 10. All the declared eligible applicants for admission on the basis of the Sports are required to give their **preference for all Colleges and all relevant Courses** on their Dashboard at DU UG Admission Portal based on guidelines outlined in Points #3to #6 above. There is no limit on registering their preferences of Colleges and Courses depending on availability of respective GAME /SPORT in the Colleges. All eligible applicants desirous of admission as per the Centralized Sports Merit list will be given **only one chance** to register their preferences for Colleges and relevant Courses at DU UG Admission Portal.
- 11. The Dashboard of eligible applicants as per the Centralized Sports Merit List on the DU UG Admission Portal will be open for registering their preferences for the allotment of Course and College from Monday, 8th November 2021 to Wednesday, 10th November 2021. All eligible applicants are informed that no further chance for registering their preferences for allotment of College and Course will be given after Wednesday, 10th November 2021.

- 12. The Centralized Sports Merit List of successful applicants along with the allotment of College and Course will be displayed on DU UG Admission Portal on Friday, 12th November 2021. The applicants are required to complete the admission formalities in their respective allotted College and Course on DU UG Admission Portal by Tuesday, 16th November 2021 (Midnight). No further extra time will be given for completing the admission formalities including submission of the College admission fee.
- 13. If Seats under Sports Category remain vacant after the First Centralized Sports Admission List of Colleges and Courses, a Second Centralized Sports Admission List drawn on previously registered preferences (i.e., 8th November to 10th November 2021) by the applicants for allotment of colleges and courses will be published after Friday, 19th November 2021. Applicants who have been offered admission in the First Centralized Sports Admission List of Colleges and Courses will not be considered in the Second Sports Admission List of Colleges and Courses.
- 14. An applicant's name appearing in the Centralized Sports Merit List does not guarantee admission in any College and any Course. The admission of the applicant is subject to the fulfillment of course-specific eligibility criteria and the availability of Seats in a GAME /SPORT in the College and Rank in the order of Centralized Sports Merit List.
- 15. Although the applicants have the option to choose as many college–course combinations as they wish, based on their Rank in the Centralized Sports Merit List, they are required to select only those Courses where they meet the specific eligibility criteria and they are required to select only those Colleges which offer seats under their specific GAME /SPORTScategory.
- 16. All admissions on the basis of sports are provisional and subject to forensic examination/verification of the originals of uploaded Merit/Participation Sports Certificate/s of the applicant. An applicant submitting false/fake Merit/Participation Sports Certificates for seeking admission on the basis of Sports shall be debarred from admission to any College for three years. Such admissions will be cancelled and FIR will be registered.
