Additional Guidelines for processing UG Merit-based CW Applications

The allotment of the Course and the College will be done by the Central CW Admission Committee 2021.

The colleges will scrutinize the applications, other documents with respect to the eligibility requirements of the allotted course. The ECC certificates has already been verified by the Central CW Admission Committee 2021 and the list of eligible/ineligible candidates is available on the website https://admission.uod.ac.in/?UG-Admission/CW-Admissions. There may be cases in which a candidate may have been allotted more than one course in a college. It such cases, the colleges should approve the applications for all the courses in which the candidate is eligible. The colleges may reject cases only when the minimum eligibility for a particular course is not fulfilled. If required, the colleges may ask for submission of documents by the candidate/s.

In the subsequent lists, if the candidate is re-allotted a new college as per his/her choice, the previous 'admission under CW category' will stand auto-cancelled without giving any intimation to the candidate. The candidate will have to pay the 'difference of fee' through his/her dashboard, if required.

Corrigendum to CW Guidelines

Kind attention: Bullet points 6 and 7 may be read as below

- There will be cases where a candidate may receive the 'Apply for Admission' link for more than one course and college. In such cases, the candidate may choose the Course of his/her choice.
- In subsequent lists, a candidate may be allotted a new Course + College as per his/her choice/ preference order. Re-allocation is an automated process by which the previous 'admission under CW category' will stand auto-cancelled without intimation to the candidate. However, the candidate will have to pay the 'difference of fee' through his/her dashboard within the stipulated time, if required.
