NOTIFICATION

In accordance to the Academic Council Resolution No. 9 dated 27.11.2020 with regard to admission of wards of the employees {(Teaching, Non-teaching (on rolls, superannuated); Temporary, Adhoc. Contractual (with three years of service) of the University of Delhi and its colleges in the various Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Professional Courses (subject to the approval of the concerned professional bodies as applicable, if any), following modalities have been approved for implementation of Ward Quota admissions in Undergraduate Courses for the Academic Session 2021-2022.

1. Total number of seats under the Ward quota as per A C Resolution No. 9(b) shall not exceed 16 (sixteen) per College.
2. The allocation of the seats will be 8 (eight) for the Teaching and 8 (eight) for the Non-teaching employees on the basis of Merit (Qualifying Examination and /or Entrance Test) subject to meeting the minimum eligibility criteria.
3. In case of a tie, the following tie-breaking rule (as per Bulleting of Information-2021) shall be applied in the order provided below:
 - i. The applicant with higher percentage of marks (aggregate of best five subjects including one language) in the qualifying examination will be considered first for allotment/admission.
 - ii. The applicant with the earlier date of birth (as mentioned in class X certificate) will be considered for allotment/admission.
4. Admission will be subject to a maximum of ordinarily 01 (one) seat for every unit up to 60 (sixty) students in a course and subject to the fulfillment of minimum eligibility conditions. Admission will be done only on the sanctioned strength of a course.
5. Colleges in which admissions are done both through DUET and Merit based, the following table is suggested for the distribution of the 16 (Sixteen) seats:

	Teaching	Non-Teaching
400 and above	8	8
201 to 399	6	6
101 to 200	4	4
61 to 100	2	2
Up to 60	1	1

6. In case seats as per above distribution remain vacant in a category (Teaching/Non-Teaching), the same can be done inter category, subject to the availability of candidates.
