Subject: Directives regarding student registration on the 'MY Bharat' portal of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (Govt. of India), participation in 'Viksit Bharat Young Leaders Dialogue (VBYLD) 2027', and constitution of 'MY Bharat College Councils' – reg.

Sir / Madam,

With reference to the subject cited above, kindly refer to the communication from the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor Secretariat, Delhi (vide UO No. 25(10)/LN/2026/260/A-2398-99, dated 09.09.2026) and the letter from the State Director, 'Mera Yuva Bharat' (MY Bharat), Delhi State Office.

Under the aegis of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, 'MY Bharat' is organizing the '**Viksit Bharat Young Leaders Dialogue (VBYLD) 2027' (National Youth Festival)** in New Delhi from 10th to 12th January 2027. To ensure the active participation of students across all institutions under the Department of Training and Technical Education in this nationwide movement, you are directed to strictly implement the following measures:

- **Constitution of MY Bharat College Council:** Ensure full cooperation with the District Youth Officers (DYO) of 'MY Bharat' to establish a 'MY Bharat College Council' in every institution. The activities of this council shall be conducted through the National Service Scheme (NSS), National Cadet Corps (NCC), and institutional Youth Clubs.
- **100% Student Onboarding:** Facilitate the registration of all students aged between 15 and 29 years on the MY Bharat portal (mybharat.gov.in). Dedicated helpdesks/facilitation desks should be set up within the institution for this purpose.
- **Active Student Participation in VBYLD 2027 Tracks:** Encourage students to actively register and compete in key VBYLD 2027 events:
 - **Stage-I Digital Quiz:** Ensure maximum participation in the digital quiz centered on the theme "*Future Governance, Urban Transformation & Citizen Services*" for the National Capital Region (NCR).
 - **Cultural & Other Tracks:** Mobilize maximum student entries for the Cultural Track (Folk Dance, Folk Song, Painting, Declamation, Poetry Writing), 'Design for Bharat', 'Hack for Social Cause', and 'Youth Parliament'.
- **Nomination of Institutional Nodal Officer:** Every institution shall nominate a senior faculty member as the 'Institutional Nodal Officer' to maintain seamless, continuous coordination with the MY Bharat Delhi State Office and the concerned DYO.

- **Weekly Progress Reporting:** A weekly progress report highlighting student registration numbers and VBYLD competition entries must be submitted every week without fail to this Directorate as well as the MY Bharat Delhi State Office.

All institutional heads must execute these directives on a priority basis to realize the national vision of 'Viksit Bharat @2047' through youth empowerment.
