(University of Delhi) Standard Operating Procedure (SOP)

The following public health measures are to be followed to reduce the risk of COVID-19 by students:

- 1. There will be mandatory thermal scanning followed by sanitising of hands for all students at the entry gate of the college. Students are advised to cooperate.
- 2. It is mandatory to wear a mask and carry a small sanitiser. No student will allowed to enter the college premises without a mask and a small sanitiser.
- 3. It is mandatory to have Aarogya Setu App installed in every student's mobile phone with bluetooth and location on.
- 4. You are advised to maintain physical distancing of 6 feet while entering the college gate and at all times during your stay in college.
- 5. Please carry a permission from your parents to attend the college.
- 6. Use of face covers/masks is mandatory at all times during you stay in the college.
- 7. Frequent hand washing with soap (for at least 40-60 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty.
- 8. Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing of used tissues properly.
- 9. Self-monitoring of health by all is essential. You are advised to report any illness at the earliest to your teacher.
- 10. **Spitting** is strictly prohibited in the college premises.
- 11. Disposable substances such as disposable masks, gloves and other materials should be disposed individually with precautions.
- 12. Sharing of eatables, books, other learning and reading material is not allowed.
