- A. Parent/Family income from all sources should not exceed ₹5 lakhs per annum.
 - (i) Certificate/Form-16 from employer in case of salaried employees.
 - (ii) Certificate issued by MP/MLA/Councillor/SDM etc. for the year 2020-21 issued after 31st March, 2021 in case of self-employed persons (Certificate/declaration issued by Notary will not be accepted in any manner).

OR

B. Secured minimum 80% overall aggregate in class 12th examination

OR

C. Participated in International Sports Event.

Condition: -

1. The student should not have availed any other scholarship from State Government, Central Government, any other statuary body during the year 2021-22.
