Students from the first and second year of the computer science department were gathered together at 8:15 am near the college entrance on 29th November 2022. After photographs and the attendance were taken, students and teachers began boarding the buses.

A total of 3 buses carried more than 160 students from our college to the first destination which was the Gandhi Smriti Museum located in Central Delhi.
