With immense pleasure, we cordially invite you to a National Seminar, which is being organized by the Department of Political Science, Deen Dayal Upadhyaya College. The theme of the National Seminar is “**State Assembly Election in North-East, 2023 (NSSAENE 2023)**”.

The objective of the Seminar is not solely to examine electoral challenges but to exchange ideas and perspectives on the historical significance of the North-Eastern States (Tripura, Meghalaya and Nagaland). The North-Eastern region has immense potential, yet the region remains significantly unexplored.
