16) Travel Grant Scheme for III/IV Year students of the College: The recommendation of Research and Development Committee (RDC) regarding introduction of "Travel Grant Scheme for III/IV year students of the College" to promote research culture among the UG students of the college out of the Research Endowment Fund Head of the College Students Welfare Fund A/c was considered. The Undergraduate Curriculum Framework- 2022 (UGCF) is meant to bring about systemic change in the higher education system in the University to align itself with the National Education Policy 2020. The objectives of NEP to promote creativity and critical thinking; to encourage logical decision-making and innovation; to promote outstanding research as a co-requisite for outstanding education and development. After due deliberations the Governing Body resolved the following:

To promote research culture among the UG students of the college, the recommendations of RDC to introduce "Travel Grant Scheme for III/IV year students of College" out of the Research Endowment Fund (College Students Welfare Fund A/c) is accepted with following Salient Features:

- I. The scheme is meant for any UG Student (III/IV Year) of the College who intends to work under the supervision/mentorship of a permanent faculty member (hereafter to be termed as *Supervisor*) of Deen Dayal Upadhyaya College.
- II. The Supervisor will submit a detailed plan of study/research work and on approval from the Principal of the College shall engage the student(s).
