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

It was further resolved to create Mentor-Mentee group of Students in each class (i.e. For every 10 undergraduate first year students, there would be a senior student as a student guide, and for a group of 20 students. there would be a faculty mentor). This will be done by the Teacher-in-charge in consultation with faculty members of the concerned department and the same shall be intimated to the office of the IQAC latest by September 12, 2018. The group should remain same for the entire duration of stay of the student in the college.
