Later, keeping pace with the Quality Mandate of UGC (https://www.ugc.ac.in/e-book/loef.pdf), Learning Outcome based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) was implemented from 2019-2020 wherein each paper clearly defines the learning outcome of the syllabus being taught both in terms of program but also the course undertaken. DU envisions all its programmes to provide focused, outcome-based syllabi for all its constituent colleges. The University offers a Learning Outcome-based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) that aims for all-round development of the youth for their own betterment and for the greater common good. In short, each programme prepares students for employability, sustainability, and life-long learning.

- The college is dedicated to a set of generic learning outcomes which are aligned to its legacy, vision and mission. These cover all aspects of student life in the college. The outcomes are dynamic and responsive to emerging areas of knowledge, job markets and the needs of students. The entire college fraternity works towards realizing these all-pervasive objectives.



framework of **UG degree programmes under LOCF** have in-built flexibility with a choice of courses in the form of interdisciplinary and open electives. The nomenclature reflects the expected outcomes. Inasmuch as classroom teaching-learning is extremely focused, within the framework of the degree programme, at the micro level, each course of study defines its own unique set of learning outcomes that are tied to the curriculum.

- The Programme Outcomes (POs) and Course Outcomes (COs) are communicated to the students well in advance through the **college website, college prospectus, Principal's address to the students and parents during the orientation, alumni meet, expert talks and dissemination in classrooms.**
- The broad objective of a specific course is communicated to students by faculty at the beginning of the session. Following effective pedagogic practice, faculty articulates the learning objective and expected outcomes for each topic. These are reiterated through discussions and small group tutorials. Continuous assessment provides feedback on efficacy of the teaching-learning process.

- In all **laboratory courses and practical sessions**, students are made aware of the importance of arriving at an outcome in consonance with the task set. The learning outcomes are evident in the form of results of the exercises set or experiments undertaken. Immediate feedback is provided to the student. Immediate remedial action is also given to ensure learning.
- The college proactively encourages **faculty to participate** in Refresher Courses, FDPs, Workshops, Seminars and Conferences so that they can gain familiarity with specific course objectives and tune the classroom teaching accordingly.
- **Technical talks by the Alumni** are organized where they interact with both the students and the teachers and share how their individual course shaped their career thus helping students align better with the specified course outcome.

The following agenda was taken up:

1. Student Induction Program for First year students as per the UGC guidelines.
2. UGC (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational institutions) Regulations, 2018.

After a long deliberation on various issues the following decisions were taken in the meeting.

Item No.1 : It was noticed that a part of the requirements of Student Induction Programme (SIP) are already being met through the orientation programme. Since the guidelines from UGC have been received late, it was resolved to cover up the deficiency during the fresher's welcome programme which as such involves socialization amongst students & faculty and may therefore be renamed as Induction Programme.

For subsequent years a proper 3-4 days Induction Programme be organized before reopening of the colleges in the new Academic Session. For working out the detailed modalities of the same, it was resolved to constitute a committee consisting of the following: -

1. Dr. Vinod Kumar, Convener
2. Dr. Jayini Adhayapak
3. Dr. Deepa Kamra
4. Dr. Manoj Saxena, IQAC-Coordinator

The committee shall also give suggestions for making provision of funds for the Student Induction Programme (SIP) to be organized during Academic Year 2019-2020 onwards.

It was further resolved to create Mentor-Mentee group of Students in each class (i.e. For every 10 undergraduate first year students, there would be a senior student as a student guide, and for a group of 20 students, there would be a faculty mentor). This will be done by the Teacher-in-charge in consultation with faculty members of the concerned department and the same shall be intimated to the office of the IQAC latest by September 12, 2018. The group should remain same for the entire duration of stay of the student in the college.

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Each Mentor shall hold regular meetings, as per UGCs' – guidelines given in – "A Guide to Student Induction Programme", with the assigned students and the attendance shall be maintained in a register. It was also decided that as a follow up after induction Program, each department shall

- Organize three-day field visit for social sensitization during the semester and,
- Organize one visit to a historical monument for the purpose of bonding as well as creating awareness about history or city.

The expenses towards travel arrangements shall be made by the college and rest of the expenses will be contributory from the students.

Item No. 2 : It was decided to constitute Departmental Academic Integrity Panel (DAIP) and Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP) as per UGC (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational institutions) Regulations, 2018.

In any other matter, the following proposals were taken up:

- Digital Sign Boards :** A proposal for installation of 5 – 6 Digital Sign Boards/LED display boards at strategic locations in the college (as it is necessary for minimizing the usage of Flex Banners and also for faster dissemination of information about college activities amongst students, visitors and staff members), was approved by the Academic Development Committee.
- Department-wise Alumni meet :** It was decided that each department shall maintain complete database of its pass-out students (i.e. Alumni) and shall motivate them to become life members of the College Alumni Association. Further, to facilitate interaction with Alumni it was resolved, that every department shall invite their respective alumni for student induction program (SIP) as well as for farewell function for final year students.
- Data Analytics Club :** Proposal for starting a Data Analytics Club submitted by the following teachers was taken up:
 - Dr. Arpita Sharma, Associate Professor in Computer Science.
 - Dr. Veena Jain, Associate Professor in Operational Research.
 - Dr. Yogieta Mehra, Assistant Professor in Management Studies.
 - Dr. Rajan Gupta, Assistant Professor (Adhoc) in Computer Science.

It was resolved to approve the same and faculty members from all Departments including of Commerce and Economics can join it.

It was also decided that every department shall maintain attendance sheets of participants of the departmental activities for the purpose of NAAC, NIRF etc. Further, every department will organize its activities involving, upto 100 students, in their respective Lecture Theaters and shall organize one full day activity on a Saturday.

Calender is available on College Website. The list of attendees activity wise to be cross-checked by Audit Committee Members during AAA.

- To Initiate Outreach Program for School Students and formal tie-ups with schools

Science Foundation under the aegis of DBT Star College Program organized School Outreach Program for Kendriya Vidyalaya -Sector 12, Dwarka Class X students. 160 students participated.

- To conduct Student Satisfaction Survey as per NAAC guidelines.

Analysis of Student Satisfaction Survey posted on IQAC homepage of College Website.

- To organize staff training workshops, programs etc.

Staff Training workshops especially in the area of IT to be organized by ICT committee in next semester.

- To study the guidelines for SSR for NAAC and give recommendations in order to improve the NAAC Score of the institution in Second Cycle for accreditation.

IQAC in its meeting held on December 12, 2018 discussed the guidelines for SSR for NAAC Second Cycle and following were recommended: (MoM available on IQAC homepage https://dducollegedu.ac.in/Datafiles/cms/file/Minutes%20of%20Meeting%20of%20IQAC_December%2012%202018.pdf)

For Students and Staff Members

1. Each Department shall prepare Learning Outcome (LO) and Program Outcome (PO) of each paper and the same shall be displayed on College Website before March 31, 2019.
2. During Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) special emphasis has to be given on the meetings and outcome of the Mentor-Mentee group meetings, so as to strengthen the same.
3. Issue of Group Insurance for regular students of the college was discussed and it was resolved to use SAF funds for covering reimbursement in case of serious medical illness and/or demise of any student.
4. Each and every student as well as employee of the college should be computer savvy and should have necessary IT skills. Therefore, provision must be made for conducting ICT workshops for all staff members and all students in ICT centre of the college.

For Faculty members

1. In order to promote publication in high quality research journals by faculty members of the college, a letter of appreciation and financial reward of Rs. 10,000 (from the Research Endowment Fund) for each publication in a Scopus indexed journal be instituted as soon as possible. Modalities of the same to be finalized by the Governing Body.
2. All faculty members should update their faculty homepage before April 30 every year.

Administrative Reforms

1. Each Activity Convener should submit a detailed report, list of participants and photographs while settling the bills, within 15 days of the activity.
2. Accounts section shall intimate the tentative fund allocation of each subject society and student society to respective TICs and Convener latest by July 15 every year. The progress of the activities organized shall be reviewed at the end of the odd semester when final allocation of funds will be done alongwith any unutilized fund of any activity.
3. All the ranking agencies like NIRF, QS Ranking, India Today etc. give a lot of emphasis on the college website. In fact, they take a lot of data from the institutional website. Therefore, it is recommended that the ICT Committee of the college should get the college website reconstructed through some good professional agency replacing the existing one by April 30, 2019.

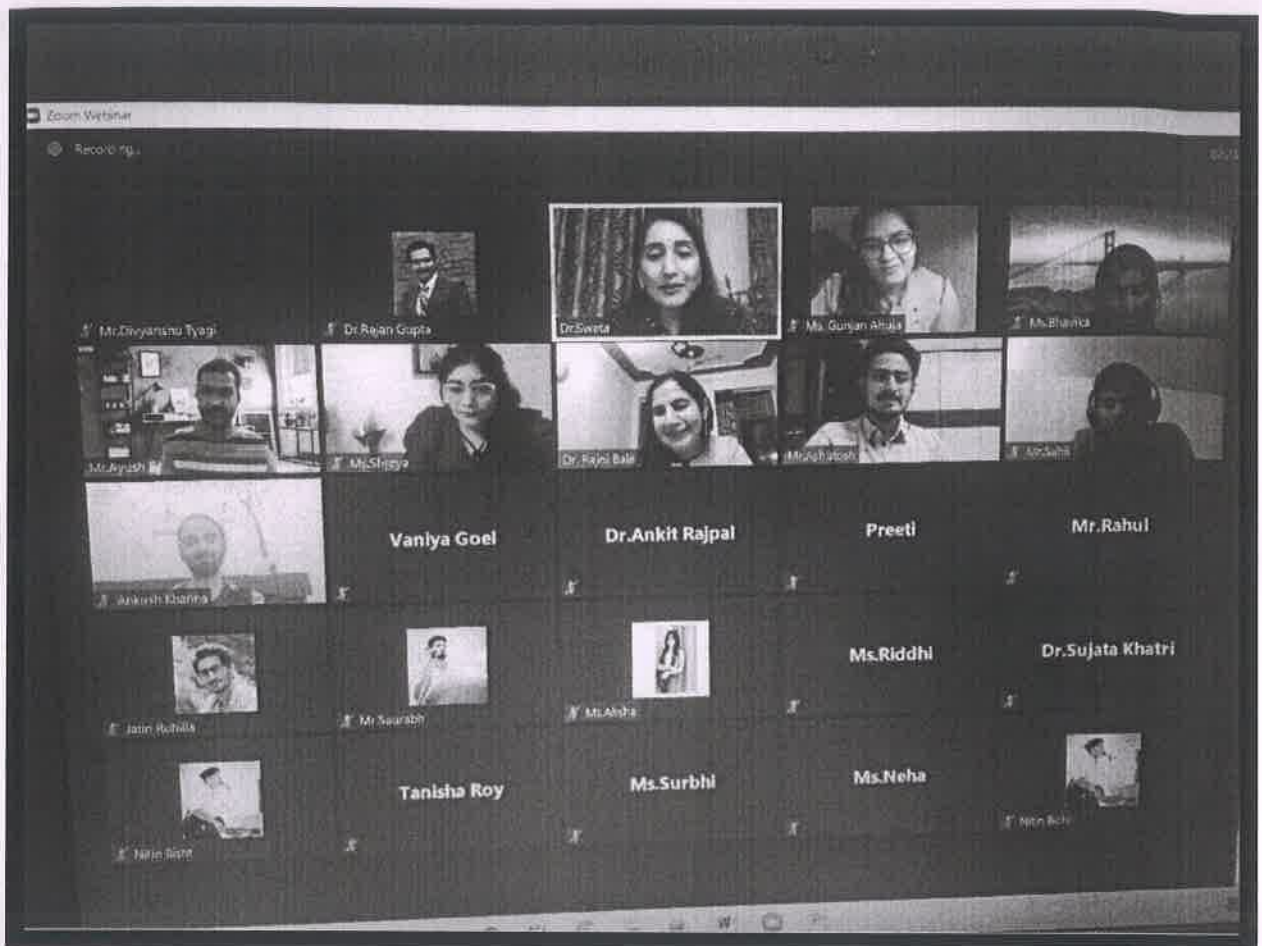



Besides the above, "**Governance in Higher Education: A Handbook for Vice-Chancellors**" is also available as an e-book.


I hope that collectively we shall overcome this tough time by taking all possible preventive and precautionary measures.
