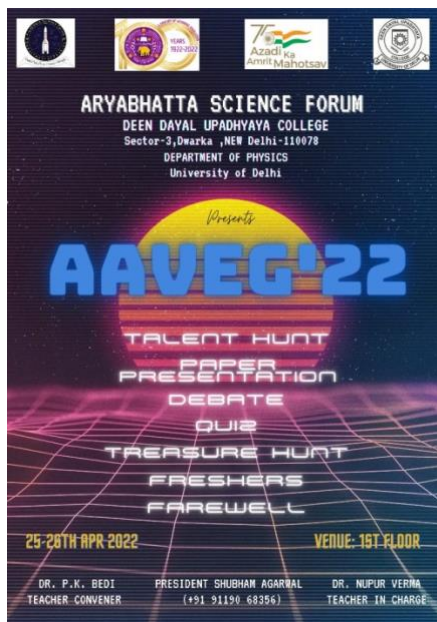


AAVEG 2022 REPORT

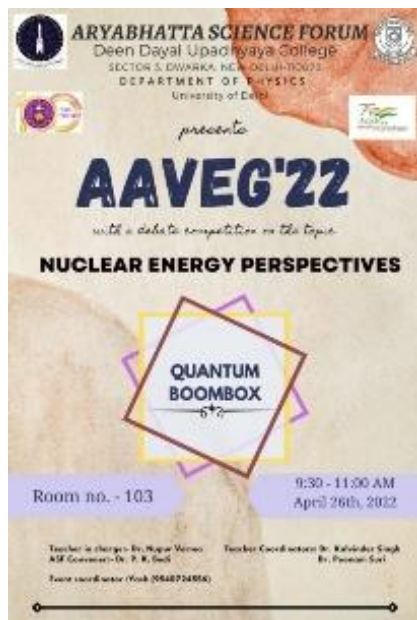
AAVEG 2022 was organized by the **Department of Physics** under the banner of Physics society, **ASF Aryabhata Science Forum** on 25-26 April 2022. The Annual Inter-College department festival witnessed enthusiastic participation from students across different colleges of University of Delhi. A broad spectrum of activities was organized during the two day festival.



A paper/poster/project competition “**Showcase**” was held on 25th April 2022 with 10 entries from different courses. The event was conducted by Dr. P.L. Meena and Dr. Sandeep Jaggi. The students presented their talk on interesting topics like cosmology, black holes, population control etc.



Debate competition “**Quantum Boombox**” was organized on 25th April 2022. The competition was judged by Dr. Kulvinder Singh and Dr. Poonam Suri.
