INTRODUCTION:



We all know the nature of science is such, that it is incomplete without experiments. To give the hints of recent experiments to the students of Physics Department we organized a visit of about 45 students along with faculty members to the INTER UNIVERSITY ACCELERATOR CENTRE (IUAC) on 29th October 2018.

Dr. P. L. Meena (Convener, ASF) and Dr. Savita Gahlaut (T.I.C. Physics Department) took the initiative and communicated with the staff at IUAC. We got permission for 45 students and collected the funds from them. On the day of visit all the students and teachers gathered in the college premises by 8:30 a.m. and left the college at around 8:45 a.m. after an attendance. We were received there by Dr. Golda who took us through a virtual trip of the accelerator centre and the going experiments through her presentation. It was followed by a tea break for the students. The students were divided into three groups for tour throughout the centre and were guided by the scientists at the centre. Students could not visit some areas due to the ongoing experiments however it was quite an informative visit which boosted our knowledge about working of accelerators. Students were shown the data that was being collected from the experiments at that moment. We were able to see some of the facilities like the National Array of Neutron detectors, General purpose scattering chamber along with some portions of the huge pelletron accelerator. This was followed by Lunch and a group photo.

The visit to the historical Qutub Minar while returning was a sprinkle of amazement and thrill on us. The visit was concluded with a group photograph in the college premises.
