## Annual Report 1991-92

Professor S.K. Khanna, Vice-Chairman, University Grants Commission, distinguished Guests, Members of the Faculty and friends:

I extend to you all a warm welcome on this occasion the 'Second Annual Day' of Deen Dayal Upadhyaya College, I am grateful to you, Sir, for accepting our invitation to be with us on this day.

Sir, I now present a brief report on the college during the last one year. The college started functioning from 21st August, 1990 with 350 students who sought admission in Science, Commerce, Arts and Vocational courses. At present there are about 525 students on the rolls in the various courses in the college.

There are about 3000 Books in the College Library and we are subscribing to 20 Magazines and 10 Technical Journals. We propose to add another five thousand books in the Library during the next academic year. There is sufficient space in the Library for 150 students to sit at a time and do serious reading.

The college celebrated its First Birthday as 'Van Mahotsava Day' on 21st August, 1991. Professor A.L. Nagar, Pro-Vice-Chancellor, University of Delhi, was the Chief-Guest on this occasion. The college organised its 'Annual Sports day' on 28th February, 1992. Mr. Mohan Atri, B.Com (Pass), 1st Year and Miss Seema, B.A. (Pass), 2nd year were adjudged as best boy and girl athletes respectively. Forty prizes and medals were awarded to the winners of the various events by Shri Ajit Pal Singh, formerly Captain of the Indian Hockey Team, who was the Chief-Guest on this occasion.

The various departments and societies organised extension lectures. The Hindi Sahitya Parishad was inaugurated by Professor T.N. Bali, formerly Head of the Department of Hindi and Dean, Faculty of Arts, University of Delhi. Inter-Class Hindi Debate and Inter-College Hindi Debate were organised by the Hindi Sahitya Parishad. The Sanskrit Society organised Sanskrit Shloka Competition in collaboration with the Sanskrit Academy, Delhi Administration. The Arts and Culture Society organised interclass competition in dance, music, fancy dress shows, quiz.

The Department of Physics invited Dr. Neeraj Khare of National Physical Laboratory, who delivered lectures to the students of science. The Department of Botony organised a field trip to Mussorie for the students of Botany and Zoology. Local excursion trips were also organised by this Department. The Commerce Department organised a field trip to the Computer Exhibition organised by PCS Data General India Ltd.

Our college students also participated in Inter-College Debate, Essay Competitions, Inter-College Sanskrit Shloka Competitions, Wrestling Competitions and won prizes for the college. Joginder Singh, Anudeep, Jitender and Udaya & Party were awarded individual prizes for participating in Inter-College Competitions.

The College is also one of the Study Centres of the Indira Gandhi National Open Uniersity.

I thank my colleagues and guest lecturers from other colleges who are assisting in our teaching programme and also to the administrative staff and college karamchari staff for their hard work.

My special thanks to the students of this college who enthuse us with their spirit and energy.

Sir, as Vice-Chairman of the University Grants Commission you occupy the most significant position in the planning process of higher education of the country. We look for many more innovative ideas and qualitative improvement in the higher education of the country under your able leadership.

With these words, I once again, extend a hearty welcome to you, Sir, on my own behalf and on behalf of the members of the staff and students of this college.
