On the basis of above, one may conclude that following are necessary for improving the Rank in next edition of NIRF.

1. We have to maintain a healthy student-teacher ratio this year also. Allocated Budget should be utilized by all departments/subject/student societies.
2. **Publication in Journals indexed in Scopus and Web of Science should be increased. Author Affiliation in all publications should be "Deen Dayal Upadhaya College, University of Delhi"**
3. To Promote research publications in scopus indexed journals/UGC listed Journal - Recommendation of IQAC made in Meeting held on December 19, 2018 http://ddu.collegedu.ac.in/Datafiles/cms/file/Minutes%20of%20Meeting%20of%20IQAC_December%2012%202018.pdf to be implemented from July 2019 where in "...In order to promote publication in high quality research journals by faculty members of the college, a letter of appreciation and financial reward of Rs. 10,000 (from the REF) for each publication in a Scopus indexed journal be instituted as soon as possible. Modalities of the same to be finalized by the Governing Body...."
4. Number of Patent filing and research project funding to be strengthened.
5. Executive/Faculty Development Programs to be organized (at least ONE by each Department)
6. **Scholarship offered (under different Government schemes) for socially challenged students (i.e. SC/ST/OBC/Minorities) to be strengthened and all eligible students should avail the same.**
7. **Budgetary support for organization of National Level Workshops/Seminars etc should be increased to improve public perception.**
8. Number of Placements has to be strengthened significantly.
9. **Students securing CGPA 9 or above in any semester to be provided laptop from ICT centre for subsequent semester for his/her academic growth and knowledge enhancement**
10. **For Women Empowerment:**
 - o Girls Common Room to be shifted to 3rd Floor and it's Infrastructure to be strengthened.
 - o Sanitary Napkin Vending Machine and Incinerator to be installed in or around Girls Common Room.
 - o Number of Female Students to be increased possibly by providing relaxation of 2% in cut-off in all courses
 - o **Providing 75% Merit Scholarship to All Girl students admitted in any course in First List declared by the college. Modalities to be framed by Fee Concession Committee.**
11. Alumni Meet to be organized at Department Level in order to maintain data for Graduating Students Admitted Into Top Universities/Higher Education Institutes
